## **Correspondence:**

**Commander Dave Harvey** discussed the following correspondence items:

- 1. **Voting: CDR Dave** stressed that we should vote in the upcoming USSVI elections. This can be done by voting online at <a href="www.ussvi.org">www.ussvi.org</a> or look for ballots in the next issue of the American Submariner. There are also issues up for vote.
- 2. **Nanotechnology:** Submarines could use nanotechnology to elude detection. University of Texas at Dallas has been working on nano-science speakers and found that they do as well underwater as they do on land. One day they could replace traditional submarine SONAR arrays.
- **3. Females on UK Submarines:** The Royal Navy has announced that female sailors will serve on UK subs.
- 4. Virginia Class Submarines, Connecticut Representative Courtney: The House last month voted to authorize building two Virginia Class submarines per year starting in 2011, a move Courtney says will help maintain and create jobs at General Dynamics Electric Boat (and Northrop Grumman's Newport News shipyard) and ensure that the military maintains its advantage at sea. However, self inflicted attack sub cuts have crippled America's sea superiority. Decreasing funds and increasing missions have put the Navy's submarine force in trouble, and its sinking fast.
- **5. New TRICARE Requirement:** Skilled nursing care facilities will have to preauthorize care provided to Medicare eligible TRICARE eligible beneficiaries once are exhausted and TRICARE becomes the primary health coverage.
- **6. Bronze Medallions for Non-VA Cemeteries:** Secretary of Veterans Affairs Eric K. Shinseki announced 6/29 that the Veterans Affairs is offering bronze medallions to attach to existing privately purchased headstones or markers signifying status as a deceased veteran.
- 7. USS Flier SS250: A memorial service is scheduled at the Great Lakes Naval Memorial & Museum in Muskegon, Michigan, on August 12-13, 2010, the 66th Anniversary of the loss of the vessel. For more info, visit <a href="http://www.ussflier.com/glnmm.htm">http://www.ussflier.com/glnmm.htm</a>.
- **8.** USS Requin SS481 Crew Reunion: The reunion, which is held every three years, will be held at the Ramada Hotel and Conference Center-Greentree 401 Holiday Drive Pittsburgh, PA 15220 Phone 412-922-8100 or FAX at 412-921-5402. - **9. Piracy Duty:** The Netherlands is sending a Walrus Class submarine to Somalia for anti-piracy duty. A single Dutch Walrus-class boat will operate in the area from September to November this year as part of NATO's Operation Ocean Shield taskforce. (Nothing like letting the pirates know who's coming after them).
- 10. Submarine Memorial Dedication in Fayetteville AK: The USS Snook Base of the United States Submarine Veterans will be unveiling a memorial monument dedicated to those submariners lost in service to our country. The unveiling will be held on Wednesday, July 21, 2010, 10:00am at the Veterans Administration Medical Center in Fayetteville Arkansas. Guests include officers from the United States Submarine Veterans, officials from the Veterans Administration Medical Center, and retired and active duty U.S. Navy Submariners. The public and other veterans organizations are
