Old Business

Veterans Day Parade Brunswick: The parade will be held on Sunday 7 November 2010. Ray Bussard has arranged for a hay wagon to hold TRI-STATE parade participants. CDR Dave has submitted the application, but has not heard from parade representatives yet. Participants will meet at the Souder Road shopping center outside of town where Roy Rogers Restaurant is located.

Veterans Day Ceremony: At 11:00 AM on 11 November 2010, there will be a Veterans Day Memorial Service traditionally held at Frederick Memorial Park. (The ceremony may be held at the Frederick American Legion. Further information will follow). The Frederick American Legion will conduct the service. The Frederick American Legion will provide lunch after the service. Our November BOD Meeting will be held after the service and lunch at either Frederick American Legion.

New Business

Donation to Fisher House: Fisher House is a favorite charity of Henry Cranford. It is proposed that TRI-STATE Base make a donation to Fisher House in Henry's name.

Holland Club Applications: Shipmate Barry Ensminger pointed out that the 2010 approved amendment to Article 7 of the USSVI Constitution and Bylaws no longer requires bases to submit names of prospective Holland Club members to National USSVI. The National Office will nominate Holland Club members. The approved amendment is repeated below for information. Changes are indicated in bold type.

Change: Revise section 4 to Constitution Article VII regarding Holland Club qualifications, dues requirements, and continuity of the Holland Club Chairman as follows: Section 4: HOLLAND CLUB

- A. Any Regular Member in good standing who has been designated "Qualified in Submarines" for fifty (50) years or more is eligible to become a member of the Holland Club within the organization.
- B. Holland Club members are subject to National and Base Dues to the same extent as other Regular Members of the organization. Holland Club members inducted prior to the effective date of this change (date) are 'grandfathered' and will continue to be designated as National Life Members, but they may be required to pay Base dues as per Base Bylaws.
- C. Holland Club member's membership cards will be appropriately stamped HOLLAND CLUB on the front.
- D. The members of the Holland Club will elect Holland Club officers including a Holland Club Chairman who will represent them directly to the organization's National Commander.
- **E.** The Membership Chairman will periodically review **ALL MEMBERS** for eligibility and initiate the admission process as Members become eligible, including a notification to the Holland **Club Chairman.**
- F. If the Holland Club Chairman position becomes vacant due to death, incapacity or resignation, the National Commander will appoint an interim Holland Club Chairman, subject to confirmation by the National Board of Directors, to serve until the next scheduled meeting of the national Holland Club.
