USS Torsk SS 423: Three Shipmates qualified onboard, Ray Bussard, Donald Gunn and Howard Wentz. The Torsk got its name from a fish allied to that Cod fish. She was built in Portsmouth Naval Yard in Portsmouth NH, with her keel laid on June 7th 1944 and she was launched in September 1944. She arrive in Pearl on 23 March 1945. Her first patrol was as lifeguard duty for bomber pilots. Post war, she returned to New London and was used as a training boat. She also made a Med run and participated in Joint training exercises. March 4th 1968 she retired, but continued to be used as a Reserve pier side Training Vessel. She had made 11,884 dives in the course of her career. 1972 she was transferred to MD and in 1973 became a display. The "shark mouth" painting was discussed by Tom Denton.
